


Fig. 2.1 • Area of intensive study and visibility zones.




Fig. 2.4 • Map from the late 19th century in half-verst scale, detail of survey area.




Fig. 2.5 • Map of the mid-20th century, scale 1:25,000; detail of Panskoe area.




Fig. 2.9 • Location of sites visited and found during the DSP extensive survey (2007).




Fig. 2.13 • Map showing locations of augerings and geological observations.
