


Fig. 5.4 • Asymmetrically shaped Bronze Age “knife” from trial trench 4 (DSP07-H08-01) seen from two sides. The bifacial working of the edges is clearly visible.



Fig. 5.5 • Fragment (cutting edge) of a battle-axe with a cylindrical perforation from DSP07-H08-01. Bronze Age.




Fig. 6.1 • Landscape types, surveyed fields and hills and sites found.
